**FROM King of Prussia and Rt. 202 corridor:** Take the EXPRESSWAY towards Philadelphia and get off at Exit 330, Rt. 320, Gulph Mills. At the bottom of the ramp, bear right on Rt. 320 (Montgomery Ave). In a HALF mile (second stoplight) turn RIGHT at the traffic light onto Matson Ford Road. Proceed ONE MILE on Matson Ford Road and turn RIGHT onto Harford Lane.

Look for #5 -- Rob's mailbox, and park along the street. Follow the LONG driveway to Rob's house -- can't be seen from the street! In Rob's words, "We are the third house on the left (number 5) sitting behind house number 3. It is not the mansion sitting close to the road. Our driveway starts at the first street light on the left-hand side of the road and is between house number 3 and the mansion."

**Parking.** Please park along Harford Lane without blocking the neighbors' driveways. If there is no more space, exit Harford Lane, take a right on Matson Ford Road and take a right at the traffic light into the Radnor Corporate Center where you will find ample parking.

**FROM MAIN LINE & SOUTH:** From Rt. 30 (at the Radnor Hotel in St Davids), turn north onto Radnor-

The River Trail on the OTHER side of the river in Valley Forge Park is a delightful walk/hike, especially in the cool weather of fall. Turn RIGHT into the park and go to the END of the road past the bathrooms on your left and park as close to the start of the trail as possible.

Come join us as we return for our 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive Fall Wine 'n Dine at Trattoria Giuseppe, a wildly popular BYOB on West Chester Pike in Edgemont. Critics say the food is out of this world while the prices are down to earth! Main Line Today says "the service is great and the atmosphere is beautiful. ....plus the portions are huge, delicious and very affordable." Recommended: the eggplant appetizer, which could double as an entrée.

The owner, Giuseppe Musso, has designed this restaurant to be reminiscent of his past experience as a Chef in Sicily. He prides himself on his sauces, spices and specialties. He says he was going for the feel of a restaurant in a Sicilian piazza. It looks like he did it. With authentic Italian clay tile, wrought iron, marble and wood combined with stone and stucco, you'll feel like you're having a momentous dining experience in Italy.

Most entrees are \$15-18; with pastas as low as \$7.

Check out their website at: [www.mussotra.com](http://www.mussotra.com) to read more about their history and menu. The restaurant is located at 4799 West Chester Pike, Edgemont. Enter off Rt. 3 (West Chester Pike) inside the same complex that houses the Edgemont Theatre complex. Just circle behind the complex behind the theatre until you see Trattoria Giuseppe (it's sort of hidden in the back)...Good news: Parking is free!

The cost will be the cost of your dinner plus 25 % added for tip and tax. We'll have one bill which we will pay, you pay us cash! **"A-B" Players** - Must have a Springton rating of 3.5 or better. The round robin schedule will be organized for maximum competitiveness, according to level of play.

## **RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSITS**

Reservations will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis, as follows:

- **Only MLSC members may go on the trips.**
- Only MLSC members may sign up prior to or during the September general meeting
- **Members of other EPSC clubs may sign up only after the September general meeting has been held and must become members of MLSC.**

Reservations are confirmed only when a deposit and a signed reservation form and release of liability are received. The deposit amount is indicated in each trip's individual description. Separate payments are required for each trip and checks should be made payable to Main Line Ski Club. No cash payments can be accepted. To take advantage of the discount policy, when offered, payment in full must be received by the early payment date.

## **SURCHARGES**

When a trip has reached its quota, a formal waiting list will be established requiring a \$25 per person deposit for weekend/bus trips and \$35 per person for major/airline trips. This deposit will be applied to the cost of the trip if a cancellation occurs and the wait-listed person is moved onto the trip. The deposit will be refunded in full if the wait-listed person is not called or if he or she cancels from the wait list prior to being called. However, if a person remains on the wait list, is called but decides they cannot go (for whatever reason) the deposit is forfeited.

## **CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS**

All cancellations must be received in writing by the trip leader. Cancellation penalties apply to all MLSC trips. Because of the complexity of financing most major trips, trip leaders establish their own cancellation and refund amounts and schedules according to the payment requirements of the airlines and lodgings. A minimum administrative fee of \$25 for weekend/bus trips and \$35 for major/airline trips is charged for any cancellation.

In the event a cancellation occurs before a trip leaves and a replacement is found, deposits and payments will be refunded, less the MLSC admin. fee and any fees charged by the airline (if applicable). In the event a cancellation occurs before a trip leaves and a replacement is not found, deposits and all payments may be forfeited. Any refund will be dependent on the payment and cancellation schedule with the airline, bus or accommodation, and any losses that might be incurred by MLSC. Please speak to a trip leader to be sure you understand this process before you sign up for any MLSC trip.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**

All costs are for double occupancy unless otherwise noted.

Trip leaders have limited information available ahead of time as to room configuration and specific amenities. While we attempt to book equal facilities for all trip participants there can be discrepancies, with condos especially, from room to room. Please try to be flexible, but if there are major issues with your assigned place, talk to your trip leader immediately upon check-in.

## **DEPARTURES**

Departure times listed in trip write-ups are subject to change, due to airline rescheduling. Be sure to communicate with your trip leader 2-3 weeks before your trip departs.

## **OTHER**

Anyone under the age of 21 must be accompanied by an adult.

The Main Line Ski Club maintains a No Smoking policy for all trips. This includes bus, condos and parties.

Laptop computers should be used only during off hours so as not to tie up the telephone. People use the phone to make ski plans early in the morning and dinner plans late afternoon/early evening. Be considerate of your roommates/condo mates when using phone lines for computer purposes.
